Entrance Requirements:

1. Completed application form with 8 photos (1"x 1 1/2").
2. Three copies of Home-Registration (Thai) or Passport (International).
3. Three copies of official transcripts and three copies of the certificate of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a GPA of at least 2.5 on a scale of 4.
4. TOEFL score of PBT 500/CBT 173/IBT 61 or IELTS score 5.0
5. Experience in teaching in an educational institution.
6. A letter of recommendation attesting to the applicant's moral character and potential for teaching and/or school administration.
