ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Submit application form with 6 photos (1x 1 ½), three copies of home-registration (Thai) or passport (international).
2. Submit three copies of official transcript and certificate of a Master's degree.
3. Submit two letters of recommendation from two different people who can attest to the applicant's ability to study in the Ph.D. program.
4. Submit a research proposal.
5. Take the AU-English Proficiency Test, Leadership Potential Aptitude Test (LPAT), and the interview. The applicants who submitted the TOEFL (iBT) 90 or (P) 575 or IELTS 6.5 or those with the Bachelor's or Master's Degree from USA, Canada, UK, Australia, and New Zealand are exempted from the AU English Proficiency Test.
