3. The fees are subject to change at the University's discretion without prior notice.
4. Attendance in the preparatory courses depends on the candidate's educational background and work experiences. Appropriate courses and workshop will be recommended to the candidate upon passing the assessment criteria. Candidates must achieve satisfactory performance in preparatory courses before proceeding to the full curriculum.
