- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
The applicants must graduate from the following academic field:
Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Information Technology, or equivalent
- Have on of the following English proficiency scores:
 - 575 or higher on the TOEFL(P),
 - 90 or higher on the TOEFL(iBT),
 - 6.5 or higher on the IELTS, or
 - pass the minimum English proficiency requirement specified by Vincent Mary School of Science and Technology
- Three letters of recommendation from lecturers or employers.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Candidates are expected to submit the following documents:

- A completed application form
- Official transcript of the previous university attended (3 copies)
- Bachelor's degree certificate (3 copies)
- Citizen identification card and residence registration (3 copies) - for Thai Applicants
- Passport (3 copies) - for non-Thai Applicants
- Six (1x1-inch size) photographs (photo in gown is not preferable)
- Reference letters from either a former instructors or employers (3 letters)
- Diploma (3 copies)

Note : All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day application period, otherwise the application will not be considered and the applicant will not be allowed to sit for the Admission interview.
