1. Completed application form with 6 photos (1"x 1 1/2")
2. Three copies of Home-Registration (Thai) or Passport (International)
3. Three copies of official transcripts and three copies of the certificate of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a GPA of at least 2.5 on a scale of 4
4. Two letters of recommendation from two different people who can attest to their moral character and other trait
5. Take the AU-English Proficiency Test and the interview. The applicants who submitted the TOEFL (iBT) 90 or (P) 575 or IELTS 6.5 or those with the Bachelor's or Master's Degree from USA, Canada, UK, Australia, and New Zealand are exempted from the AU English Proficiency Test.

1. Have completed all the courses of the curriculum.
2. Have obtained a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00.
3. Have passed the oral and written comprehensive examination.
4. Have proposed the independent study and passed the final oral independent study defense evaluated by a committee appointed by the University. The final oral defense is open to the public.
5. Have the independent study/part of the independent study published in any retrievable form.
6. Have proposed the thesis and passed the final oral thesis defense evaluated by a committee appointed by the University. The final oral defense is open to the public.
7. Have the thesis/part of the thesis published or have obtained an acceptance of publication in a national journal or international journal in accordance with OHEC's Regulations on Criteria for Selection of Academic Journals for Publication of Academic Works (B.E. 2556) or have presented it at a conference and the full paper published in the proceedings.

8. Have obtained library and financial clearance from the University.
9. Have demonstrated good behavior and discipline.
