### QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION

Applicants should meet the credentials and submit the materials stipulated as follows when seeking admission into the Program.

1. Bachelor's degree in any field from the institutions accredited by the Ministry of Education, Thailand
2. A minimum CGPA of 2.00 on 4.00 scale or equivalent for the bachelor's degree

### ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form
2. Official transcript of the previous university attended (1 copy)
3. Bachelor's degree certificate (1 copy)
4. Citizen identification card and house registration (1 copy) - for Thai applicants
5. Passport (1 copy) - for Non-Thai applicants
6. Three (1x1.5 inches) photographs (formal attire, not in graduation gown)
7. Resume
8. Two recommendation letters from two persons
9. Statement of purpose indicating the applicant's objectives for pursuing a master's degree

Applicants who are graduates from overseas Universities will be required to provide at the time of applying and not later, certified, attested, or notarized by competent notaries, all academic documents with the seal or stamp by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education or related department.

**ADMISSION FEE** 1,000 THB (Non-refundable)

### EXEMPTION

The AU English Proficiency Test can be exempted depending on which of the following conditions you satisfy.

- a TOEFL score of (iBT) 90 or (PBT) 575 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (Validation: Two years)
- a Bachelor's degree or a higher degree from native English speaking countries (e.g. USA, Canada, UK, Australia and NewZealand)
