Assumption University is a non-profit institution administered by the Brothers of St. Gabriel, a worldwide Catholic religious order, founded in France in 1705 by St. Louis Marie De Montfort, devoted to education and philanthropic activities. The congregation has been operating many educational institutions in Thailand since 1901.

- 1969 Assumption Commercial College in 1969 as an autonomous higher education institution under the name of Assumption School of Business.
- 1972 Official approval by the Ministry of Education and established as Assumption Business Administration College or ABAC.
- 1975 accredited by the Ministry of University Affairs.
- 1990 Granted new status as "Assumption University" by the Ministry of University Affairs.

JOINT PROGRAM WITH OVERSEAS UNIVERSITIES

For joint programs, students may undertake foundational courses at Assumption University (AU) that lead to a Master's degree offered by partner universities. This coursework may span 1-2 semesters at AU, followed by another 1-2 semesters of full-time study at the overseas partner universities. Degrees are conferred by the partner institutions upon the satisfactory completion of all course requirements.

DEGREES

- The university offers a wide range of graduate courses and research degrees, ranging from 1.5 to 3 or more years in length.
- All programs are taught in English and accredited by the Thailand Commission of Higher Education, Ministry of Education.
- Full-time and part-time programs are available, with master's programs lasting 1-2 years and doctoral programs lasting 3 years.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO GRADUATE STUDIES

Each graduate program has its own specific admission requirements, but all graduate programs generally require applicants to have:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited institution to apply for a master's program
- A master's degree from an accredited institution to apply for a doctoral program
- A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or its equivalent
- A good command of English
- Computer literacy
- A passing score on the university English proficiency test (or a TOEFL score of (iBT) 90 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (valid for two years))
- An interview
