## DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

**3-YEAR PROGRAM**  
**COURSEWORK + DISSERTATION**

### Graduates from the PhD (IT) Program will

1. Have advanced knowledge and understandings of information technology and/or innovation as well as the implications of information technology and/or innovation for individuals, organizations, and the broader society;
2. Have ethics and highly developed cognitive skills relevant to the tasks of problem solving and discovering new knowledge in the field of Information Technology;
3. Have highly developed skills in the analysis of quantitative and qualitative information;
4. Have highly developed leadership and interpersonal skills;
5. Have highly developed communication skills essential for successful sharing of knowledge and understanding of information technology with others.

### QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION

Admission to the program is granted to applicants with:

1. Master's degree in Information Technology or in other related fields
2. GPA of at least 3.25 out of 4.0 or equivalent

### ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form
2. Official transcript of the previous university attended both of Bachelor and Master (1 copy)
3. Bachelor's Degree Certificate (1 copy)
4. Master's Degree Certificate (1 copy)
5. Citizen identification card and house registration for Thai Applicants (1 copy)
6. Passport for Non-Thai applicants (1 copy)
7. One (1x1.5 inches) photograph (formal attire, not in graduation gown)
8. Letter of recommendation from former instructors or employers at the time of the application (2 letters)

*Note: All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day of application period. Otherwise, the application will not be considered and the applicant will not be allowed for the Admission interview.*

Applicants who are graduates from overseas universities will be required to provide at the time of applying and not later, certified, attested, or notarized by competent notaries, all academic documents with the seal or stamp by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education or related department.

### ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

- AU English Proficiency Test
- Interview Entrance Examination

### EXEMPTION

The AU English Proficiency Test can be exempted depending on which of the following conditions that you satisfy.

- TOEFL score of (iBT) 90 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (Validation: Two years)
- a Bachelor's degree from native English speaking countries (USA, Canada, UK, New Zealand and Australia)

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

#### Type 2.1: Coursework and Dissertation

- Have completed all the courses of the curriculum
- Have obtained a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00
- Have passed the proficiency test of English
- Have passed the qualifying examination
- Have passed the dissertation defense
- Have a publication or obtain an acceptance of a publication related to the content of the dissertation in a journal which has peer review and which is approved by the Academic Committee of the department
- Have obtained library and financial clearance from the University
- Have demonstrated good behavior and discipline
