QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION

1. Bachelor's degree in any field from institutions accredited by the Ministry of Education, Thailand
2. A minimum CGPA of 2.50 on 4.00 scale

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form
2. Official transcript of the previous university attended (1 copy)
3. Bachelor's degree (1 copy)
4. Citizen identification card and house registration (1 copy) - for Thai applicants
5. Passport (1 copy) - for Non-Thai applicants
6. Three (1x1.5 inches) photographs (formal attire, not in graduation gown)

Applicants who are graduates from overseas Universities will be required to provide at the time of applying and not later, certified, attested, or notarized by competent notaries, all academic documents with the seal or stamp by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education or related department.

ADMISSION FEE 1,000 THB (Non-refundable)

EXEMPTION

The AU English Proficiency Test can be exempted depending on which of the following conditions you satisfy.

- a TOEFL score of (iBT) 90 or (PBT) 575 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (Validation: Two years)
- a Bachelor's degree or a higher degree from native English speaking countries (e.g. USA, Canada, UK, Australia and New Zealand)

Duration of Study

Students are expected to complete all the requirements of their degree within the two-year period of their study. However, students' candidature can be extended for a maximum of 5 years.
