The ABAC Ph.D. in Hospitality and Tourism Management (Ph.D. HTM) Program is the first International Tourism PhD program in Thailand and continues to be the pre-eminent program with small class sizes, and students from ASEAN. The program is delivered in English by international faculty members, all of whom have a wealth of experience in Tourism and Hospitality sectors.

The Ph.D. HTM program is delivered through a series of seven modules arranged in a combination of conventional lectures, tutorials, seminars, workshops and out-of-class activity-based learning experiences. With one intake per year registration can be made at any time with the program commencing in September each

After completing the seven theory modules in their first year students are assigned an individual supervisor who is a renowned researcher in the student's research area. Students may elect to complete their dissertation in one to four years.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION

- Hold a Master's Degree in related fields (MBA, Msc in
- Tourism) or equivalent degrees in any other fields, with GPA above 3.50 on a scale of 4.00 or equivalent.
- Have at least 3 years of work experience in organisationsin the area of interest and expertise.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from either formerinstructors or employers.
- Present a brief research proposal in the field of hospitalityand tourism studies.

- A completed application form
- Bachelor and Master's Official transcript of the previous university attended (1 copy)
 Bachelor and Master degree certificate (1 copy)
- Citizen identification card and house registration (1
- copy) for Thai applicants
- Passport (1 copy) for Non-Thai applicants
- One (1x1.5 inches) photograph (formal attire, not in graduation gown)

Note: All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day of application period, otherwise the application will not be considered.

Applicants who are graduates from overseas universities will be required to provide at the time of applying and not later, certified, attested, or notarized by competent notaries, all academic documents with the seal or stamp by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education or related department.

EXEMPTION

The AU English Proficiency Test can be exempted depending on which of the following conditions you satisfy.

- a TOEFL score of (iBT) 90 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (Validation: Two years)
- a Bachelor's degree from native English speaking countries (USA, Canada, UK, New Zealand and Australia)

GRADUATE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Complete the total number of credits of the program
- Achieve a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00
- 3. Have the dissertation / part of the dissertation published or have obtained an acceptance of its publication in a national or international journal in accordance with OHEC's Regulations
- 4. Maintain proper conduct worthy of being a doctoral degree holder
- 5. Settle all financial obligations to the University
- 6. Fulfill the requirement of an out-of country fieldtrip
