## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form.
2. Official transcript of the previous university attended (1 copy).
3. Bachelor's degree certificate (1 copy).
4. Citizen identification card and house registration (1 copy) - for Thai applicants.
5. Passport (1 copy) - for Non-Thai applicants.
6. One (1x1.5 inches) photograph (formal attire, not in graduation gown).

Note: All documents must be endorsed with a signature and submitted in person by the last day of the application period. Otherwise, the application will not be considered.

*Applicants who are graduates from overseas universities will be required to provide all academic documents with the seal or stamp of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education, or related department at the time of application and not later, certified, attested, or notarized by competent notaries.*

### Exemption for English Test

The AU English Proficiency Test can be exempted if you satisfy one of the following conditions:

- A TOEFL (iBT) score of 90 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (valid for two years).
- A Bachelor's degree from native English-speaking countries (USA, Canada, UK, New Zealand, and Australia).


