QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION

- 1. A bachelor's degree or equivalent from an accredited institution in any field.
- 2. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale.
- 3. Proof of English proficiency with one of the following:
 - TOEFL: at least 575 (PBT) or 90 (iBT)
 - IELTS: at least 6.5
 - A passing score on the English Proficiency Test of the Graduate School of Business and Advanced Technology Management, Assumption University.
- 4. Successful completion of an interview with the program's admission committee.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- · Completed application form.
- One (1 x 1.5 inch) recent photograph (formal attire, not in a graduation gown).
- Passport copy (for non-Thai applicants).
- Copy of Thai national ID card and house registration (for Thai applicants).
- Bachelor's degree certificate (one copy).
- Official transcript from the university previously attended (one copy).

Note: All documents must be signed for verification and submitted in person by the application deadline. Incomplete or unsigned submissions will not be considered.

Applicants who earned their degree from an overseas university must provide, at the time of application, certified or notarized academic documents bearing an official seal or stamp from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Education, or a related government department.
